Restoring Dental Implants: A General Dentist's Guide

This course, which is directed to the general dentist, hygienist, and staff, is a review of the implant treatment planning and implant restoration solutions available today. There will be a comprehensive discussion of each type of restoration design (single tooth, crown and bridge, hybrid, and overdentures). In addition to the clinical steps for success, other topics openly addressed will include lab fees, length of treatment, complications, and maintenance. The main goal of this course is to provide the clinician and staff with a strong background in implant treatment planning to meet the growing patient demand and interest, which has increased exponentially in recent years and is expected to boom in the coming years. Advanced topics such as anterior esthetics and CAD/CAM technology will be touched upon as well.
