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
Background:

PN presented with broken tooth #10 and wanted to have an immediate tooth replacement options which was not removable.

Initial Findings:

Based on the 3D cone beam scan, the broken tooth #10 had sufficient bone to perform computer guided implant surgery for the purpose of immediate implant placement and immediate loading of the implant #10.

Pre-Operative Photographs








Computer Generated Surgical Guide

Steps:

After fabrication of the surgical guide from the 3D software, the guide allowed precise implant placement and loading of a premade customized screw retained provisional with shade matching capability from the Trios digital scanner.








Case Conclusion:

When applicable, computer guided implant surgery in combination with prefabrication of the immediate loading provisional can allow for reduced pain, treatment time and costs for the patient to receive an immediate provisional restoration on the day of extraction with implant surgery.
